CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE BY-LAW NO. 4658

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories, to amend the Boxing, Wrestling and Other Combative Sports By-law No. 4396, as amended, for the City of Yellowknife.

PURSUANT TO section 70(1)(h) of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T. 2003, c.22, which provides that the Council of a municipality may make by-laws for municipal purposes respecting programs, services, infrastructure and facilities provided or operated by or on behalf of the municipal corporation;

AND PURSUANT TO section 60(1) of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T. 2003, c.22 which provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, establish a board or commission to administer or provide a service, public utility or facility as an agent of the municipal corporation;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular sessions duly assembled, enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

That By-law No. 4396, as amended, be amended by:

- 1. Amending paragraph 1 by deleting the Short Title <u>Boxing</u>, <u>Wrestling and Other Combative Sports By-law</u> and replacing therewith "Combative Sports By-law".
- 2. Deleting the definition of "Regulated Sports" and replacing therewith:

"Regulated Sports"

means professional boxing, professional wrestling, mixed martial arts, full contact karate, kickboxing, muay thai and sports that hold contests between opponents involving striking with knees feet, orelbows, submission grappling, take or downs."

- 3. Amending paragraph 3(a) by deleting "and training quarters for persons in training for the regulated sports".
- 4. Deleting paragraph 3 (c).

"(b)

- 5. Amending paragraph 3 (e) by deleting "may" and replacing therewith "shall".
- 6. Amending paragraph 4 by deleting "and training quarters for persons in training for the regulated sports."
- 7. Deleting paragraph 9(b) and replacing therewith:
 - The Commission shall arrange to provide such medical, police, referees, judges, officials or supervisory personnel as the Commission deems proper, to be in attendance at any contest or exhibition in order ensure that such bout, contest or exhibition shall be conducted in a safe and orderly manner, and may require the promoter person in charge of any bout, contest exhibition to pay such amount as will cover cost of providing medical, police, referees, judges, officials or supervisory personnel and may withhold the issue of any permit until the person concerned has made arrangements satisfactory to the Commission to pay such amount, provided that in case a promoter or person in charge considers the amount charged by the Commission, is, under particular circumstances, unfair excessive, the promoter or person in charge may appeal to Council within 14 days from the date the amount objected to was charged by the Commission and in case of an appeal within the time limited, the decision of the Council shall be final and binding."
- 8. Amending paragraphs 5 and 7 by deleting "Secretary-Treasurer and replacing therewith "Executive Director".

- 9. Deleting paragraph 6 (d) and replacing therewith:
 - (d) (i) All combative sports events involving Boxing shall be conducted in accordance with the rules for boxing contests set by the Nevada State Athletic Commission as amended from time to time.
 - (ii) All combative sports events involving Muay Thai shall be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set by the World Muay Thai Council as amended from time to time.
 - (iii) All combative sports events involving Kick Boxing shall be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set by the World Kick Boxing Association as amended from time to time.
 - (iv) All combative sports events involving Mixed Martial Arts shall be conducted in accordance with the Unified Mixed Martial Arts rules and regulations set by the Nevada State Athletic Commission as amended from time to time.
- 10. Amending paragraph 12 by deleting "All permits issued by the Commission shall be subject to the said conditions and shall have printed on the face thereof, a copy of this paragraph of the by-law".
- 11. Amending paragraph 13 (1) by inserting "Medical Supervisors" after "Judges".
- 12. Amending paragraph 17 by deleting ",three (3) of which must reside in the City,".
- 13. Deleting paragraph 21.
- 14. Amending paragraph 25 by inserting "professional" before "wrestling" in both instances.
- 15. Deleting paragraph 26.
