FIRE BAN IN YELLOWKNIFE

Due to extremely dry conditions, the City of Yellowknife has implemented a fire ban on July 19, 2024. The fire ban prohibits open air burning and discharging of fireworks within city limits, including the use of approved fire pits, and will remain in effect until further notice. The use of camp-stoves, enclosed BBQs, and Canadian Standards Association (CSA) approved propane-fueled appliances are permitted. Outdoor propane-fueled burners are also permitted for heating and/or cooking, but must be used within the confines of a fire pit.

FREE HOME AND PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS

The City of Yellowknife Fire Division (YKFD) is conducting free home and property assessments for Yellowknife residents. This assessment will highlight areas of risk and provide specific recommendations of actions and upgrades residents can take to increase their property's resilience to wildfire.

The program's primary purpose is to engage homeowners in voluntary wildfire mitigation activities by offering a home assessment with property-specific recommendations. This program is being offered in collaboration with FireSmart Canada, FireSmart NWT and homeowners in Yellowknife.

PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR 2025 BUDGET

The City of Yellowknife invites residents to help shape the 2025 budget. Residents can submit project proposal(s) from **Wednesday, July 17, 2024 to Friday, August 16, 2024** via an <u>online form</u> on the City's website.

This new form allows residents to submit a complete project proposal with a cost estimate, giving consideration to <u>Council's Strategic Directions</u> and to tax and service implications. Residents are asked to complete all sections to the best of their ability. The information collected will allow Council to more easily assess the feasibility of the projects proposed and their alignment with Council's objectives. Residents are reminded that the City is not permitted to run a deficit budget, and as such, any increased costs associated with the proposals submitted must be funded through a tax increase or a service/program reduction.

AFTER ACTION ASSESSMENT – 2023 NORTH SLAVE COMPLEX WILDFIRES

A fire extinguisher will assist in controlling and extinguishing a small fire in your home or office:

Use: P.A.S.S.; if you don't know the meaning, don't use it!

Size: 2A 10BC (A: Every solid object that burns; B: Flammable

liquids – grease & oil; C: Electrical).

Location: Mount it near an exit door.

Servicing: Annually (powder cakes and pressure drops over time).

Reminder: Evacuation is your first priority.
